


Figure 1 China's policy system for SFCRS

In January 2010, State Councilor Liu Yandong pointed out during his investigation in Hainan that the construction of an international tourist island is all-round, and that the construction of an international tourist island should be based on education, guided by science and technology and supported by culture. Although the SFCRS in Hainan's universities has made some progress in just a few years, due to the relatively weak foundation of higher education in Hainan, it is difficult to carry out reciprocal cooperation with well-known foreign universities and to introduce more high-quality foreign education. Resources, there is still a big gap between the requirements of SFCRS and the construction of an international tourist island. At present, there are only seven Sino foreign cooperative education projects approved and filed in Hainan Province, involving three Hainan universities and five foreign universities, and all of them are at the junior college level, as shown in Table 1, which is far from meeting the requirements of building an international tourism island.

In the rapid development stage of cooperative education, colleges and universities at all levels focus on the development of this field, but in the face of cooperative education, the teachers needed are relatively weak, and there is a shortage of specialized and new-born teachers with development prospects. At the same time, cooperation in running schools has higher requirements for teachers. It not only helps students to conduct cross-border learning, but also integrates with foreign courses and teachers, and more needs to use bilingual teaching. This makes teachers not only have solid professional knowledge, but also be proficient. The use of foreign language teaching is a great pressure on teachers' resources for college teachers who lack overseas training and further studies. In addition to the higher requirements for teachers' teaching quality, students have to face the pressure of professional English proficiency test when they study cross-border. In teaching, bilingual teaching method also has very high requirements for students' quality. However, due to regional differences, the lack of high-quality students in the cooperative education projects is also a big problem.

# 3. The Development of Hainan Universities' Mode of Foreign Cooperation in Running Schools under the Background of Internationalization of Higher Education

### 3.1. Significance of SFCRS in Hainan

SFCRS can fill many professional and even academic vacancies in Hainan universities, enrich their own educational resources and adjust the educational structure. 


Figure 2 The target structure of SFCRS and the corresponding map of course categories
