On this basis, it integrates scene teaching method, and employs relevant artists to guide teaching so as to achieve teaching penetration. Finally, it realizes the test of this teaching achievement through curriculum design. Table 2 shows the overall mastery of the students participating in learning, from which we can see that more than half of the students can grasp this art form well, which shows the effectiveness of the methods described in this paper.
