Analysis on Social Network of Chinese Government Microblog

Abstract: SINA Weibo was born in August 2009; three months later, China's first government Weibo account, "Weibo Yunnan" registered. After nearly ten years of development, the development of China's government microblog has reached a relatively mature and stable level. However, it is undeniable that government micro-blogging still has some defects in management and operation to a certain extent, which urgently needs our further standardization and improvement. In view of the fact that microblog network is also an important part of social network, this paper studies the social network characteristics of government microblog, and studies its overall characteristics, classification and individual network influence. The author hopes to provide valuable suggestions for the healthy and sustainable development of government microblog.

1. Introduction

With the continuous development and progress of Internet technology, the network has already been applied to all aspects of people's daily life. As an open Internet social service platform based on Web3.0 platform, China's microblog, represented by SINA Weibo, has become an important way of information dissemination. For the vast network user group, it is the medium to obtain information, exchange ideas and communicate feelings; for the government, companies and other organizations, it is an effective tool to release information, commodity marketing, and strengthen propaganda. The Chinese government recognized its value at the beginning of the birth of micro-blog, a new media, but the development of government micro-blog in China is not smooth sailing. Since the birth of the first government micro-blog account, government micro-blog has been launched all over the country for two years. 2011 is known as the first year of Chinese government microblogging. In 2018, the number of government microblogs became sTable. The development of government microblogging in China has gone through three stages: the initial stage of spontaneity, the stage of large-scale growth and the stage of sTable development. Now it has reached a relatively mature and sTable level. However, it is undeniable that government micro-blogging still has some defects in management and operation to a certain extent, which needs further standardization and improvement. In view of the fact that microblog network is also an important part of social network, this paper studies the characteristics of social network of government microblog, and explores the relationship between the various nodes of social network in the perspective of government microblog. The author hopes to provide valuable suggestions for the healthy and sustainable development of government microblog.

2. Overview of Government Microblog

The 42nd Statistical Report on the Development of Internet in China issued by China Internet Information Center (CNNIC) shows that as of June 30, 2018, the number of Internet users in China had reached 802 million, with a penetration rate of 57.7%; as of June 2018, the number of users of online government services in China had reached 407 million, accounting for 58.6% of the total number of Internet users; Party and government organs at all levels and mass organizations actively used micro-scale. New media such as Blog, WeChat and Client, publish government information, respond to social concerns, promote collaborative governance, and constantly improve the level of local government information publicity and online service. As a leading province in the development of new government media in China, Guangdong Province has a total of 99.84 million

users of WeChat City Service, ranking first in the country, 9936 government agencies and the second in the country.

In April 2018, General Secretary Xi Jinping gave a systematic explanation of the important ideas of the network power at the National Conference on network security and information technology. On December 27, 2018, the General Office of the State Council issued Opinions on Promoting the Healthy and Orderly Development of New Media for Government Affairs, pointing out that: implementing the strategy of strengthening the country through the Internet, implementing the responsibility system of network ideology, vigorously promoting the healthy and orderly development of new media for government affairs in the government system, continuously improving the government's ability to perform functions on the Internet, and striving to build "fingertips" that are beneficial to enterprises, convenient to the people, bright spots and satisfactory to the people. Online Government. By 2022, a new pattern of standardized, innovative and integrated development of new media for government affairs will be formed.

2.1 Definition of government microblog

Government microblog refers to the official accounts registered and authenticated by government agencies on the microblog platforms represented by SINA Weibo and Tencent Weibo. It is the first important tool for government and public interaction in the new media era. Nowadays, microblog is a medium that people connect with people all over the country. To a certain extent, microblog is also a place where people express their views and opinions on a hot social event and form public opinion. As an important part of the emerging media micro-blog, it also benefits from the special position of the government in society. Government micro-blog naturally has the function of guiding public opinion, providing political participation, discussion and political service for the vast number of network users from all walks of life, and in information disclosure, public opinion guidance, listening to public opinion, news propaganda, shaping the image of the government and public participation in political affairs. Social management innovation has played an irreplaceable important role. In addition to the micro-blog accounts registered and authenticated by governments at all levels, government micro-blog also includes micro-blog accounts registered and authenticated by government staff as the main body, which attracts the attention of a large number of netizens and triggers a "micro-blog politics" upsurge.

There are two types of government micro-blogs. Firstly, the same organization has different policies in different regions. 2.3 The value of the existence of government microblog

Micro-blog is a kind of social software nowadays, and people can get information they want to see from it. They can also publish some photos, utterances on micro-blog. Guizhou Province ranked behind belongs to underdeveloped areas, which meets the conditions and becomes the best choice for underdeveloped government micro-blogging. That is to say, they will take Guangdong and Guizhou as examples to analyze a series of data of high-developed and underdeveloped areas.
