According to the dynamic changes of the environment, seasons and various factors, it is necessary to master the development trend of the tourism industry, construct a diversified and rich tourism system, and continuously extend the tourism industry so as to make the rural economy develop well.

The relationship between rural tourism and the rural economy is mutually promoting and restricting and involves many levels of economic development.
